Jumping Equitation will be run under 2012 PCAQ Jumping Equitation Rules, including rules for uniform and gear. Riders will compete in 2 rounds of Jumping Equitation. One or both rounds may have a skill Task included. This will be displayed on the course plan.

Jumping Equitation and Showjumping rules:

All events to be run under current PCAQ Showjumping and Equitation rules, inc rules for uniform and gear. The organising committee reserves the right to combine/split or omit classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, to alter advertised times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason and transfer competitors between sections of a class (SJ Rule book 2012, Pg 23 Item J & Pg 1 Item 5.10 & Under riders may enter either class 1 or class 2 for this competition. 12 & under riders may ride graded or ungraded horses, but should enter only a horse that they normally ride at pony club. No Performance card required. Riders in A, B, C, D and Pony & Galloway must have a performance card. Performance cards for graded events must be handed in to organizing committee before the start of competition (7.30am). Pony and Galloways must not exceed 15hh. Riders may choose either Pony and Galloway or a graded class but may not compete in both on the same horse. Height Class riders competing in graded classes can not ride a graded horse under 80cm. Riders may enter one competitive horse in the Official and one Competitive horse in the height classes OR two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the entry form and ridden after competitive horse. Protests to be lodge within 30min of results or incident and accompanied with a \$50.00 fee. No championship Rug for champion Senior Rider. If less than 3 Riders in any class championship rug will not be awarded.

1. If required before movement, all horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Nambour Showgrounds.
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Nambour Pony Club Committee.
5. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by the Nambour Pony Club Disputes Committee.
6. In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse including feeding and watering.
